

Climate and energy


- A strong governance regulation: permanent dialogue platforms, cocreation of national climate and energy strategies with cities
- A long term 2050 decarbonisation strategy and targets
- Strengthen support to the Covenant of Mayors initiative: empowers European cities to reduce their emissions by 23% by 2016

Financial support

- More support for mutual learning, capacity building and peer reviews for greener cities
- Scale up existing initiatives that delivers results like the Covenant of Mayors and Urban Water Agenda 2030



Focus: Oslo's climate budget






Bologna's operative plan for urban regeneration


Financing opportunities for Sustainable Energy & Climate Action Plans
